Citizens of Palmetto

All of us are aware in recent days of the rapid spread of the coronavirus across the world and in our country. We are watching this situation very closely and I urge you to do the same.

We have received calls and inquiries here at City Hall regarding our continued level of services to our citizens and the community. I want to reassure you that at the present time, there has been no curtailment of our services. We are working very closely with our partners at the Fulton County Health Department and the Fulton County Emergency Management Agency to stay abreast of the situation.

In accordance with CDC and Georgia Department of Public health Guidelines, we have taken the following steps to minimize the risk to our citizens.

Public Meetings

The Zoning Board of Appeals meeting scheduled for March 24 is cancelled.

The City Council Work Session scheduled for April 2 is cancelled.

The City Council Meeting scheduled for April 6 is cancelled.

The Planning and Zoning Meeting scheduled for April 7 is cancelled.

Municipal Court

The Municipal Court Hearings and Arraignment set for April 7 have been reset until June 2.

City Facilities

All rentals and events scheduled for the Palmetto Depot, the Palmetto Community Center and the Carter Center are cancelled until further notice.

City Utilities

All electric, water, sewer, garbage, etc. past due and scheduled for disconnect on March 22, 2020 will be extended for 30 days.

Everyone is asked to continue to follow these CDC and Georgia Department of Public Health Guidelines regarding prevention of the spread of this illness:

Avoid close contact with those who are sick

Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then discard it in the trash

Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth

Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces and objects


Stay home if you are sick
